## DIRECTOR'S LETTER

Dear Friends,

It's just about time at last for **Farmer's Market Card** distribution. AIM's distribution day for the cards is **Tuesday, June 10, from 9am to noon**. This was the first available date AIM could get for the event.

As you did last year, please call for an appointment slot — starting NOW. No need to wait until the first of the month. Please call 410 889 7915. Just as last year, you will come to Keswick's Wise and Well building at 700 W. 40th Street. Also, you can act as a proxy for someone else.

However, please know there are some program changes compared to last year: First, after registration, your card will be mailed to you. If you still have last year's card, just throw it away.

Also, we have been reassured that significantly more farmers will have the equipment this year that enables them to scan your card.

Another important change this year: it is possible to register for a card online so that you don't have to come to Keswick at all. The site already opened on May 15 (a date announced too late to include in the May newsletter). We hope to have the link by the time you receive this newsletter. Please call 410 889 7915 if you would like to register online.

Final change: in previous years, AIM received about 300 cards to distribute. This year, no one site will have a pre-allocated supply of cards. All cards will be distributed on a first come/first served basis, online registrants included. The team registering your card at Keswick should be able to tell us if cards have run out when you come in. We are doing our best to roll with these changes.

## TRANSPORTATION BY REQUEST: SCHEDULING YOUR RIDE

To get access to the TBR program, first you must be an AIM member.

- \* **Reservation required. Please call AIM's office at 410-889-7915 at least two weeks prior to your appointment.** We know that lead time seems long, but this is the price we pay for being excellent, affordable, and in demand.
- \* The driver will pick you up from home 30 minutes before your appointment time. When you are ready to be picked up from your appointment, call AIM and we will send a driver back.
- \* When you reserve your ride, the coordinator will tell you the fee, calculated at a per-mile radius rate (under two miles = \$5). Please pay the driver when you enter the car or call AIM to pay by phone (pay by phone only if ride is over \$15). We accept cash, check, Zelle, CashApp or money order. Fees are calculated as round trip only.
- \* **Medical appointments are always given FIRST priority for rides. At times, AIM may contact you to reschedule your non medical ride.**
- \* AIM only drives to non-work destinations and does not make return trips after 2:30pm.
- \* The minimum appointment time is one hour. If your appointment ends before one hour, please call, but you may have to wait up to an hour for pick up.
- \* **Prepayment is NOT required for this program (it is only required for group trips)**

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## **\$3 WEDNESDAY GROCERY SHUTTLES: RESERVE AHEAD**

The Wednesday shuttle stops at Walmart and other grocery stores and banks at the Nottingham location. Return trip is 12:30pm. Please limit purchases to two (2) bags, or what you can carry. **ALL riders MUST call AIM at 410 889 7915 to reserve a seat before close of business Mondays.**

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***Should I tip my driver? Tips are neither required nor requested. However, if you wish to acknowledge excellent service by your driver, you are more than welcome to offer a tip.***

- ◇ **AIM will start taking reservations MONDAY, JUNE 2. Calls tend to come in all at once, so if we don't pick up, please leave a message with the trips you want, and we will call you back to confirm.**
